## Crete Summer School of Linguistics at the University of Crete (CreteLing)

The Crete Summer School of Linguistics focuses on the study of language as a cognitive system. The CreteLing approach emphasizes the importance of theoretical linguistics in all interdisciplinary research. It is aimed at students and researchers in linguistics and related scientific fields (computational linguistics, neurolinguistics, speech therapy, cognitive psychology, etc.) and has succeeded in creating an interactive and interdisciplinary academic environment.

The program offers 21–24 different courses, including introductory classes and specialized seminars in theoretical linguistics, computational and historical linguistics, animal communication systems, sociolinguistics, language acquisition, and psycholinguistics.

The primary scientific and educational goal of CreteLing is to advance the educational and research standards of linguistics in Eastern and Southern Europe (Greece, Turkey, the Balkans, and other Mediterranean countries), and to create new opportunities for young scholars by promoting their research

(through internal workshops), fostering collaborations, and supporting the discovery of innovative research themes and areas.

#### **Demographics:**

The school hosts approximately 215 participants annually from 33 different countries, representing 43 nationalities. Roughly 60% of participants are graduate students and faculty members, while 40% are undergraduate students.
